## DIRECTIONS & PARKING

### Via Highway 30:

*See "Parking" for descriptions of the options.*

#### Memorial Union parking:

- Exit at University Boulevard (exit sign says Iowa State University).

- Head north on University Boulevard passing Reiman Gardens, the football stadium, and Hilton Coliseum.
- Turn left at the stoplight onto Lincoln Way and head west to the Memorial Union.
- Parking is available in the Memorial Union Parking Ramp for a small fee. The parking ramp and the Memorial Union are on the right hand side of the street. See picture here: <http://www.fpm.iastate.edu/maps/buildings/building.asp?id=88>
- Walk north to the library. See custom map.

#### Commuter Lot parking:

- Exit at University Boulevard (exit sign says Iowa State University).
- Head north on University Boulevard passing Reiman Gardens and the football stadium.
- Turn left on 4<sup>th</sup> street.
- Turn right at the third or fourth entryway to the parking lots.
- Park in the lots directly surrounding the shuttle stop. (see custom map)
- Ride the shuttle to the library. See picture here: <http://www.fpm.iastate.edu/maps/buildings/building.asp?id=148>

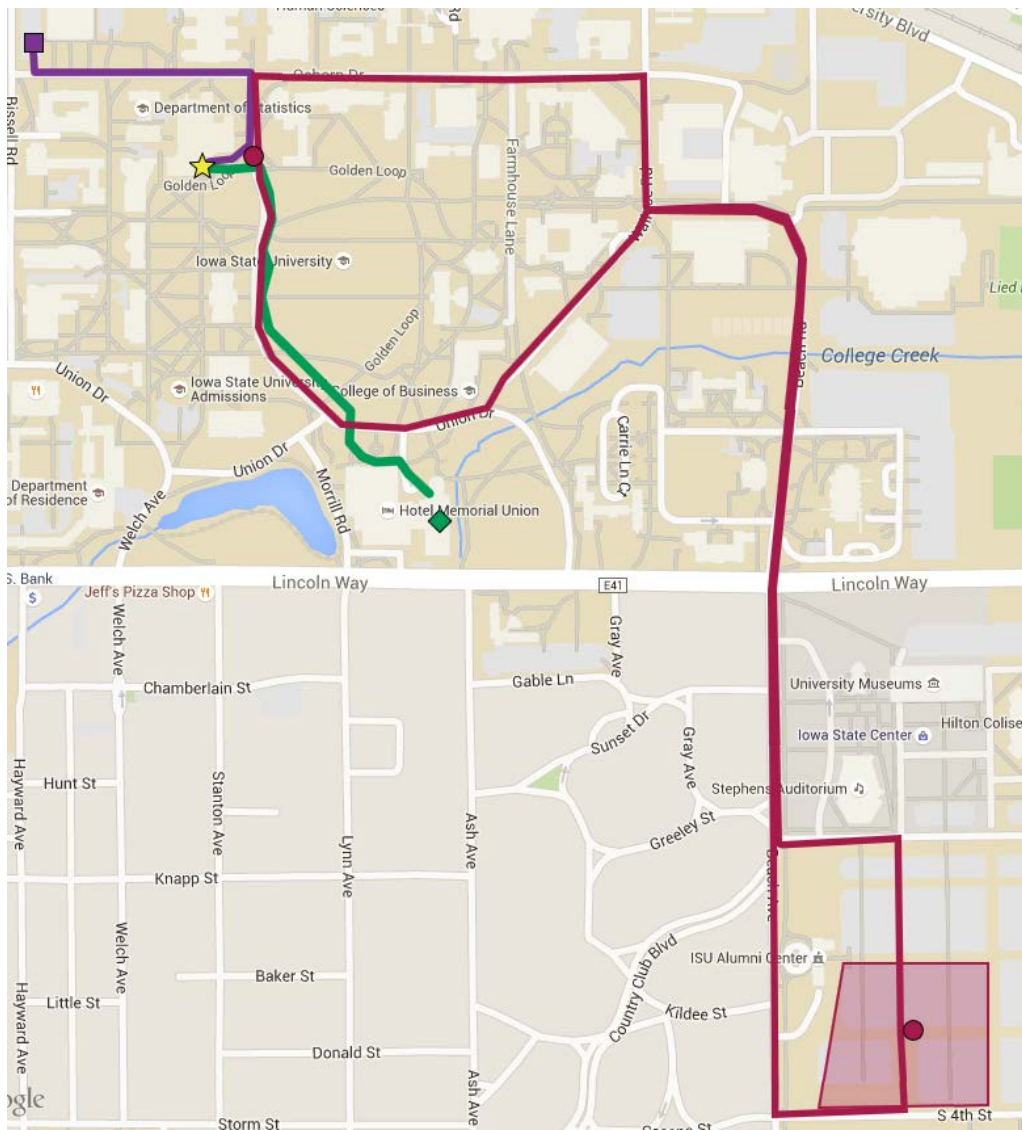
#### Armory metered parking:

- Exit at University Boulevard (exit sign says Iowa State University).
- Head north on University Boulevard passing Reiman Gardens, the football stadium, and Hilton Coliseum.
- Continue across Lincoln and follow University Boulevard as it curves to the west and becomes Pammel Drive.
- Stay on Pammel Drive past most of the campus.
- Turn left on Bissell Road once you reach the armory. (A building on your left with a rounded roof). See picture here: <http://www.fpm.iastate.edu/maps/buildings/building.asp?id=10>
- Turn left into the parking lot and park at any metered spot.
- Walk east and south to the library. See the custom map.

#### Via Highway 35:

Exit at Highway 30 West (exit sign says Iowa State University). Then follow the directions above.

### Three parking options in order of convenience

1. Green diamond route (Union): Park at the Memorial Union and walk north to the library. Fees are per hour up to a daily maximum of \$12.00. See chart: <http://www.mu.iastate.edu/en/parking/>
2. Red circle route (Commuter lot): Park at the commuter lot and ride the shuttle in. The shuttle always stops at the library, so there is no need to pull the cord or count stops. Free, but likely to be crowded.
3. Purple square route (Armory meters): Park at the armory metered lot and walk. COINS ONLY. May be crowded during the academic year.

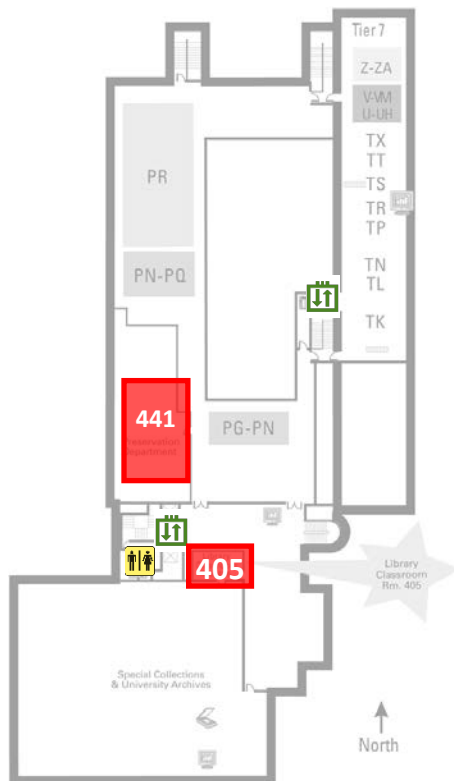

### On Campus

Hub Grill & Caribou Coffee are located in same building and are very close to the library.

Hub Grill and Café – located directly across the walkway from the library entrance. The Hub offers bakery items, a grill, cold lunch items, and hot soups. Next to the grill is Caribou Coffee which offers specialty drinks, coffee, cold lunch items, and baked goods. Open for both breakfast and lunch.
